a. Navigating and Tracking Deregulatory Agenda (Jay)

Federal Register

- Visit Federal Register and create an account under "My FR" to receive alerts on topics of interest.
- Use the search function (e.g., search "NAAQS") to find relevant publications.
- Click "Subscribe" on your search results to receive email notifications when new items are published.

Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs (OIRA)

- OIRA, part of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), provides insight into regulatory reviews before rules are proposed in the Federal Register.
- The **Unified Agenda** outlines planned regulatory actions by agency. EPA is typically listed under "Other."
- You can view current or past agendas and filter by agency to see upcoming actions (e.g., regional haze plans).
- Some entries include abstracts and EPA contact information.
- Review timelines are typically ~60 days but may vary.
- Stakeholders can request meetings with the Executive Office.

EPA Newsroom

• Sign up for EPA news releases to stay informed about proposed actions.

Executive Orders

- Executive orders can be tracked daily through the above platforms.
- A slide deck with direct links to all resources will be shared.

b. Roadless Rule Repeal by USDA (Michael)

Presenter: Michael Orman

- USDA is proposing to repeal restrictions on road construction and logging, shifting responsibility to states.
- For more information or to discuss responses, contact Graham Bates (graham.bates@deq.oregon.gov).
- Potential impacts include regional haze, PM2.5, and water quality.

c. Discussion on Anticipated Round 3 Regional Haze Rule (Committee)

- EPA has indicated plans to overhaul the rule, starting from the statute.
- A draft rule was expected in late June but has been delayed.
- The Unified Agenda suggests a potential Federal Register publication in September 2025, though this may be a placeholder.

3. Actions/Updates

- **a.** Any new actions for discussion or awareness?
 - i. IMPROVE Monitor cost-cutting updates (Scott Copeland)
 - FLMs reviewed satellite data and prioritized monitoring sites.
 - Proposal: Only publish a list of sites considered for reduced monitoring, not core sites.
 - Feedback from MJOs is due by **September 12**.
 - A vote is expected at the **October Steering Committee** meeting.
 - Final 2024 improved data expected by **September 5**.

ii. Colorado Regional Haze action

- Drafting a response to EPA comments (due **September 15**).
- Other states may submit supportive comments.
- EPA has received 9 comments, none posted yet—possibly due to staffing or policy changes.
- Colorado consulted with Oklahoma, Utah, and Wyoming; no additional measures were requested. Unclear if SIP changes will impact neighboring states.

 - Draft agenda has been emailed.
