Rollcall

Arizona ozone attainment determination excluding international emissions

Final rule. EPA approved AZ 179B on March 17

Jay Baker: any other states looking to do a 179B?

Ryan Bares: EPA may issue proposal to their 179B for moderate maintenance

Ted Lendis: Clark County intends to submit a 179BA; attached to SIP; concerned whether EPA will approve it. 179BB is backup. Submitting both to ensure concurrence.

Ken Miller: For ozone nonattainment, submitted 179B in 2021. EPA has not yet acted on or responded to it. Not even from current administration.

Ethylene oxide risk and technology review

Proposed rule. Some reconsiderations from 2024 rule; enclosure requirements; interpretations about how EPA reviews NESHAPs in future

ACI standards

Proposed rule. Two actions: 1) EPA looking to move rules for ACIs that only burn wood waste, yard waste, clean lumber in to a new subpart; 2) remove Title V requirements. Will be panel discussion at spring meeting. EPA is accepting comments.

Large municipal waste combustors voluntary remand and five-year review

Final rule. EPA is finalizing an NSPS and emission guidance. SLTs need to submit plan or negative declaration. Deadline is March 10, 2027.

Advanced Clean Cars I lawsuit

Feds are challenging this program in California. EPA is arguing that they are preempting fuel economy standards set by USDOT.

## CASAC

New members have been announced and seated. Need to be on-boarded yet. Will look at PM2.5. 2024 review was not on standard five-year cycle. Still waiting to hear about vacation. NO2 is under consent decree deadlines for review and rule writing.
